

Modify PC 4.3.1 as follows (to reflect difficulty in attending hands on)

Replace SER 4.3.1 with:

At least 60% of the persons on board shall have a certificate showing completion of Safety at Sea courses as follows:

- (a) At least 30% of the crew, **and not less than two**, including the Person In Charge, shall have completed a US Sailing Sanctioned International Offshore with Hands On (aka ISAF or Two-Day) course within **six** years of the start of the race, and
- (b) The remainder of the 60% shall have completed the course referenced in (a) or shall have completed, in person or online, a US Sailing Sanctioned Offshore Safety at Sea course within **five** years of the start of the race.

A person from outside the US may petition the Technical Committee to approve an equivalent course sanctioned by their national governing body.

The table below is intended to help clarify the rule above. The first column is crew count, the second column is how many must satisfy part (a) above, and the last column is how many additional must satisfy part (a) or part (b).
